School group - Haiku Junior (including Senryu) Guidelines

Entries

- Poems should be previously unpublished, and not submitted or accepted for future publication. We classify poems appearing in online or print magazines/journals, in or out of New Zealand, as previously published. We also classify poems that have appeared on a public website or blog of anyone other than the author as previously published.
- The students' names must be recorded only on the entry form. This is to ensure that the entries are judged blind. Submissions with any other form of identification on the poems themselves will be disqualified and entry fees will not be returned.
- Each entry must be the original work of the student. Please ensure each haiku is clearly attributed to the correct student.
- Entries must be typed.
- Haiku should be in English. Entries that are primarily in English and incorporate other languages are fine. But a translation should be provided on a separate, following page.
- When submitting multiple haiku, each haiku should start on a new page.
- The number of entries is unlimited, but the organisers reserve the right to limit the number selected for publication by one author.
- Entries will not be kept, so please ensure that all students have kept copies of their work.
- Entry constitutes acceptance of all terms and conditions.
- Please note that in the event of a poem being awarded a prize or selection for our anthology, we will request the student's personal contact details.
- If you are 18 years old but part of a school group, you may still enter as part of that school group.

Prizes

Haiku Junior section

1st prize	NZ\$100 (the Jeanette Stace Memorial Prize)
Secondary School - 3 prizes	NZ\$50 each
Primary/Intermediate - 3 prizes	NZ\$50 each

No entrant will receive more than one cash prize. Up to 20 commendations.

Junior \$1 per haiku

For each group of 10 haiku, the fee is discounted to \$9.

How to enter

Entries must be received by **31 May 2021**.

Our competition is running solely online this year. Entries must be submitted by email. Fees can be paid either by bank deposit or PayPal. PayPal includes a small fee to cover costs.

- Your haiku as a single Microsoft Word or PDF attachment

Pay your entry fee by bank deposit or PayPal

- **Bank deposit** - deposit payment to account number: 06-0501-082337110. Remember to put your name and the word "competition" in the reference fields.
- **PayPal** - Please do not send money directly to the NZPS PayPal. Sending direct does not take the PayPal transaction cost into account, and you will end up underpaying your entry fee. Results will be published on our website by **31 August 2021**. By then entrants will be notified if their poems have won or been selected for publication.

Publication

All poems entered must be made available for publication in an anthology. This anthology is to be published by the NZPS in November. NZPS has the right of first publication of all poems accepted for the anthology.

Winners consent to the use of their poems for promotional purposes by the NZPS including but not limited to our website, social media and magazine. Copyright in individual poems will remain with the poet, but copyright in any book produced by The New Zealand Poetry Society Inc will remain with the NZPS.
